



Roger Carter studied with Sylvia Gostelow and Christopher Scarf and later with Richard Popplewell, gaining Fellowships from the Royal College of Organists and Trinity College of Music. He counts himself lucky to have been able to gain experience from the opportunity of playing many different types of organs in various countries. In 1984 he was awarded a Belgian Government Scholarship to study with Flor Peeters at the Mechelen International Summer School. Following participation in the International Summer Academy in Haarlem in 1988, he was invited by Harald Vogel to take part in a recital on the city's historic organ in the Church of St Bavo. In 1993 he studied early Italian music on organs of the period in Tuscany with Luigi Ferdinando Tagliavini. He is Director of Music at St John's Church, Harpenden and is often invited to tutor on organ courses. He teaches regularly for various organisations including the Royal College of Organists.
