

Roger Carter studied with Sylvia Gostelow and Christopher Scarf and later Richard Popplewell, gaining Fellowships from the Royal College of Organists and Trinity College of Music. He counts himself lucky to have been able to gain experience from the opportunity of playing many different types of organs in In 1984 he was various countries. awarded Belgian Government a Scholarship to study with Flor Peeters at Mechelen International Summer School. Following participation in the International Summer Academy Haarlem in 1988, he was invited by Harald Vogel to take part in a recital on the city's historic organ in the Church of St Bavo. In 1993 he studied early Italian music on organs of the period in Tuscany with Luigi Ferdinando Tagliavini. Until February 2023 he was Director of Music at St John's Church, Harpenden, and is now playing and directing in various churches. He is often invited to tutor on organ courses, and teaches regularly for various he organisations including the Royal College of Organists.
