

Rosemary Knight is a Lancastrian born and bred. She studied German at UCL and taught German for a time before joining a major IT company where she trained as a systems engineer and spent the rest of her working life, mostly supporting a global financial system for General Motors.

She began learning the organ in Skelmersdale and has played in various churches since 1978, when a church in Hoxton was desperate. Since July 2013 she has been organist and choir director at Holy Trinity Leverstock Green in Hertfordshire. She is also a member of the St Albans Bach Choir.

Following a company takeover she was able to take early retirement in 2009, and spend more time on music. A pupil of Roger Carter, she passed the CertRCO in spring 2013, and in the same year she gained an MA in historical musicology from Goldsmiths, University of London.
