New organ to be installed early 2009 by E J Johnson & Son of Cambridge, incorporating pipework from the previous organ by W T Hewitt 1887, 1896, 1911 and Page & Howard 1988.

All unenclosed on direct electric action.

Position: bracketed on North wall

Console: moveable at East end, Stoptab, occupying minimum 'footprint'
